Thank you for your email of 2 May 2018, and accompanying letter, regarding the proposed variation to the *Environment Protection and Biodiversity Conservation Act 1999* (EPBC Act) conditions of approval for the above project. I note in that letter your agreement to the Department's proposed variation to the conditions of approval.

As a delegate of the Minister for the Environment and Energy, I have decided to vary the conditions attached to the approval in accordance with section 143(1)(c) of the EPBC Act. The action must now be undertaken in accordance with the varied conditions set out in the attached notice.

Please note that Condition 3 allows you, under certain circumstances, to implement a revised approved environmental management plan without seeking the Minister's approval. I have attached for your information guidance on 'new or increased impacts' and changes to approved management plans under EPBC Act environmental approvals.
